The Kent Street Coalition Facebook Group exists primarily to build community and move people to action in support of the values and goals set forth in our Mission Statement.

As we head toward the November 2026 elections, we are focused on actions that will push back against the rise of right-wing extremism and authoritarianism, strengthen and restore our democracy and win elections.

To this end, we set forth the following guidelines:

1. Shared Values. We welcome any and all who support the principles and goals outlined in our KSC Mission Statement.

2. Primary Purpose. Our primary purpose is to connect people to impactful and meaningful action.

3. Consensus-based. We focus on those issues where we have broad agreement and clear consensus.

4. Respect for all. All must be treated with respect. Personal criticisms and attacks will not be tolerated. While differences in strategy and approach are expected, we ask that members refrain from questioning or impugning the motives or intentions of others.

5. Non-violence is a core principle. Kent Street Coalition is committed to peaceful and non-violent political action and resistance. Any and all posts that advocate violence or suggest that others should engage in violence will be promptly removed.

6. Doxxing is strictly prohibited. We will remove posts that list any personal information (such as home address, personal phone number, etc.) that may be used to harass another person.

7. Not a News Feed or Forum for Debate. This group is not a forum for political debate nor is it intended as a newsfeed. As an all volunteer organization, we lack the capacity to monitor or moderate challenging and difficult conversations, that while important, are better suited to in-person and/or other carefully curated discussion groups.

8. Commitment to truth and accuracy: Before posting, we ask members to vet articles and information for accuracy and provide their sources for reference.

9. Events and actions posted here may be shared. We are a semi-private group, meaning that while the content remains private, anyone on Facebook can find the group and identify individual members. Facebook does not allow direct sharing from semi-private groups. Because of the nature of Facebook, no one should assume anything written here is truly private. Events and actions may be shared through cut and paste.

10. Kent Street does not endorse candidates ahead of the primaries. To keep this group a neutral space during the primary season, we ask members to refrain from posting candidate endorsements, personal preferences, or information about campaign events in contested primary races. Comments or posts that advocate for or against particular candidates will be removed.

11. Fundraising is not permitted, whether through direct solicitations or event promotion. This includes political events that require a donation for attendance, or that fail to clearly state that attendance is available free of charge. Some exceptions may be made for in-kind donations, such as food drives at rallies.

12. The Moderators have broad discretion to approve, deny or add posts in order to further the stated purposes of this group. The Moderators have broad discretion and authority to deny or remove posts that do not conform to these guidelines. This is especially true of posts that detract from our primary focus on action and consensus.

13. The Moderators reserve the right to remove and/or block members who violate these guidelines.

14. Disclaimer: Unless posted by a Moderator on behalf of KSC, all opinions are strictly those of the person posting. These guidelines may be updated and amended, as circumstances require. We must operate within Facebook guidelines and rules. We follow broader guidelines as required by Facebook for all of its groups.

Please note that the moderators of this group are volunteers who work hard to create a space that is fair, inclusive, and respectful to all. Because we are not able to monitor the site 24/7, comments that violate these guidelines may occasionally appear before we are aware of them. We do our best to address inappropriate comments as quickly as possible once they are brought to our attention. If you have questions or concerns, please message the moderators directly.
